

## *How to reach Nocelle*

### **By car from the south:**

Take the A3 motorway Naples-Salerno, exit at Salerno and head in the direction of Vietri, where you then take the SS 163 coastal road towards Positano. Once you reach Positano, continue along the coast road (without going down into Positano itself) until you reach the first turn to the right, in the direction of Montepertuso-Nocelle. Nocelle is 4 km along this road, which ends at a large parking lot. Park your vehicle in the area allotted for visitors and enter the village by means of the stairs at the end of the parking lot.

### **By car from the north:**

Take the A1 motorway for Naples. After the "Caserta Sud" exit, take the A3 motorway for Salerno, in the direction of the "Penisola Sorrentina". Exit at Castellamare di Stabia and follow the signs for Sorrento. Once you reach Piano di Sorrento, follow the signs for Positano, where you take the turn to the left in the direction of Montepertuso-Nocelle. Nocelle is 4 km along this road, which ends at a large parking lot. Park your vehicle in the area allotted for visitors and enter the village by means of the stairs at the end of the parking lot.

### **By train:**

From Naples Central Station (Piazza Garibaldi), take the Circumvesuviana (a local train running from Naples to Sorrento) to Sorrento where, at the station entrance, you will find the SITA bus stop. Take the SITA bus that runs from Sorrento to Positano to Amalfi and, in Positano, get off at the Chiesa Nuova (Bar Internazionale). From here, a local bus company, Flavio Gioia, runs a regular service to Nocelle (tickets available from the driver).

### **From Naples Capodichino Airport:**

- Take the ANM bus (which leaves approximately every 20 minutes) or a taxi down to the Naples Central Station and follow the directions above.
- Take the Curreri bus (regular service to Sorrento) to Sorrento and follow the directions above.
- Take the ANM bus (which leaves approximately every 20 minutes) or a taxi down to the Naples port area, from where ferries run (although not during the winter) to the Amalfi Coast.

### **By sea:**

Positano can be reached from all of the principal ports between Naples and Salerno.
